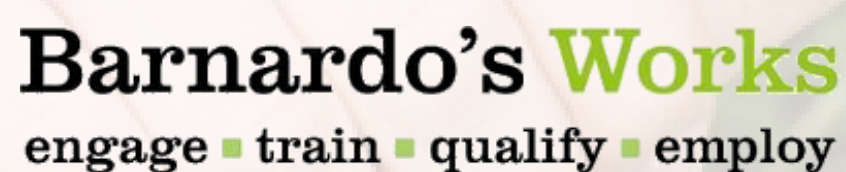
Access to Industry work with individuals to support them into employment or education, bring specialisms in supporting those with substance misuse or disclosure barriers.
