Dundee What Services does All in **Dundee provide?**

All in Dundee provides four services within Dundee:

The Employability Pathway

The Employability Pathway is a service designed to support the unemployed people of Dundee. The primary aim of the Pathway is to support every client in a tailored and holistic way, in order to move them into sustainable and secure employment

Parental Employment Support(PES)

PES supports under-employed and unemployed parents in Dundee, with the aim to support them to find/or progress in work, and increase their income, through support and guidance.

Individual Placement Support(IPS)

IPS is a clinical support model delivered by ENABLEWorks in partnership with NHS Tayside. It is designed to support individuals with severe and enduring mental health issues, to move forward into sustainable employment, and a more independent life.

Digital Dundee

Funded by STV Children's Appeal, and in partnership with D&A College, All in Dundee partner ENABLEWorks has teamed up with Dundee and Angus College to deliver digital skills training any individual with a disability or complex barrier, who is looking to move into the digital sector for future learning and employment.
