How does it work?

Once you are referred to Barnardo's Works you will be assigned to a Key Worker

Your Key Worker will discuss your employment aspirations, and then work with you to create an Action Plan for supporting you on your journey towards employment. This may include:

- Job Search Skills (e.g. Interview techniques, Confidence building, CV Writing)
- ✓ Work Placements
- ✓ Volunteering

During your time with Barnardo's Works you will receive regular support from your Key Worker who will re-assess and revisit your Action Plan on a regular basis. 16/17 year olds will receive a Young Person's Allowance.


